Ministry standards are Level 3 = approximately 70% - 75%

Cover essential concept(s) of a subject	Cover subject in greater depth				
Focus on practical application and real-life situations	Focus on theory, practical application and abstract thinking				
More one on one learning in classroom setting	Students works independently in class and at home				
Focus on skill development	Student has good foundation of skills that are applied to classroom learning				
Smaller class sizes	Large class size; need to be an independent learner

- 1 credit in Canadian Geography (grade 9)
- 1 credit in Canadian History (grade 10)
- · 1 credit in the Arts\*\*
- · 1 credit in Health and Physical Education
- · 1 credit in French as a Second Language
- 1 credit in Technological Education (grade 9 or 10)
- · 0.5 credit in Career Studies
- · 0.5 credit in Civics and Citizenship
- 1 credit from the STEM-related course group








