

Grade 10 → 11 Course Selection for 2025/2026

Step 1: LOG INTO myBlueprint.ca

- Use school email account
- If you can't access your account, you will need your OEN # (found on all provincial report cards) and an email address
- Activation Key - Ambrozic

Step 2: SELECT YOUR COURSES

- In the High school planner, select your 3 Compulsory credits, 5 elective credits & 1 alternative
- **Compulsory Credits:**
 - English (ENG 3E1, NBE 3C1, ENG 3CD, ENG3C1, NBE 3U1, ENG 3UD, ENG 3U1)
 - Math (MEL 3E1, MBF 3C1, MCF 3M1, MCR 3U1)
 - Religion (HRF 3O1, HRT 3M1)
- **Elective Credits** – Points of Consideration
 - Consider courses that satisfy Group 2 or Group 3 Graduation requirements
 - **Sciences** are electives (they are **NOT MANDATORY**)
 - COOP – 2 credit or 4 credit
 - Earn credits while gaining workplace experience
 - Satisfies Group 2 & 3 graduation requirement
 - PAI 3O1 – Small Groups Phys Ed – course fee associated with course
 - When choosing Grade 11 courses, consider what Grade 12 courses you are potentially interested in taking; you need to consider pre-requisite courses
 - Choosing an alternative is MANDATORY

Step 3: SUBMIT YOUR COURSES

- myBlueprint course selection will be open as of Tuesday February 18th
- Registration closes at 12:00 noon on Monday February 24th
- Verification - **print off the verification form** and have **parents sign**
- Once courses are submitted, you will no longer be able to change them in myBlueprint; you will have to meet with your guidance counsellor and submit a course change request form signed by parent/guardian

Step 4: Pay Activity Fee

- \$45
- Pay via School Cash Online
- Print receipt and attach to Course verification form

Step 5: Submit verification form and activity fee receipt

- Tuesday February 25th & Wednesday February 26th
- Submit during lunches in Cardinal Avenue

IMPORTANT NOTES

- If you are planning on **taking a course in summer school**, **DO NOT select** that course in myBlueprint; instead choose another elective credit (if you do not follow through with this, you **MUST NOTIFY** your guidance counsellor to ensure the class is added back into your timetable)
- Consider SHSM Programs – NonProfit & Sports
