Step 1: LOG INTO myBlueprint.ca

- Use school email account
- If you can't access your account, you will need your OEN # (found on all provincial report cards) and an email address

Step 2: SELECT YOUR COURSES

- In the High school planner, select your 2 Compulsory credits, 4 - 6 elective credits & 1 alternate

- Compulsory Credits:

- o English (ENG 4E1/OLC4O1, ENG 4C1, ENG 4U1, ENG 4UD)
- o Religion (HRE 4O1, HRE 4M1, HZT 4U1)
- **Elective Credits** Points of Consideration
 - o Consider courses that satisfy Group 2 or Group 3 Graduation requirements
 - PLF 4M1- Phys Ed Leadership There may be an interview for admittance to this course; mandatory for Sports SHSM students
 - HSC 4M1 Catholic Leadership new course; There may be an interview for admittance to this course
 - COOP 2 credit or 4 credit
 - Earn credits while gaining workplace experience
 - Satisfies Group 2 & 3 graduation requirement
 - o PAI 401 Small Groups Phys Ed course fee associated with course;
 - YRBK 2 credit course (IDC 4UP, AWD 4M1) No pre-req needed & fulfills
 Art Credit for students who are missing the requirement; students may be
 interviewed
 - Need 6 U/M courses to apply to Degree Programs
 - Choosing an alternate is MANDATORY

Step 3: SUBMIT YOUR COURSES

- Registration will be open as of Monday February 24th
- Registration closes at 12:00 noon on Monday March 3rd
- Verification **print off the verification** form and have **parents sign**
- Once courses are submitted, they will no longer be able to be changed on myBlueprint; you will have to meet with your guidance counsellor and submit a course change request form signed by parent/guardian

Step 4: Pay Activity Fee

- \$45
- Pay via School Cash Online
- Print receipt and attach to Course verification form

Step 5: Submit verification form and activity fee receipt

- Monday March 3rd & Tuesday March 4th
- During lunches in Cardinal Avenue

IMPORTANT NOTES

- OSSLT is a graduation requirement; if you were not successful, consider OLC 401
- If you are planning on taking a course in summer school, DO NOT select that course in myBlueprint; instead choose another elective credit (if you do not follow through with this, you MUST NOTIFY your guidance counsellor to ensure the class is added back into your timetable)
- We recommend you select 8 courses; by doing this it increases the number of available sections for classes (the number of sections of a class depends on how many students selected that class); this provides options for students when pathway changes are made the following year
- Part-time student status will not be permitted; this means that each student must be enrolled in a minimum of three courses each semester
