Grade 11 COMPULSORY COURSES

English (ENG 3UD, ENG 3U1, ENG 3CD, ENG 3C1, NBE 3U1, NBE 3C1, ENG 3E1)

Math (MCR 3U1, MCF 3M1, MBF 3C1, MEL3E1)

Religion (HRT 3M1, HRF 3O1)

Do not select a course you KNOW you will be taking in summer school; instead choose an additional elective course in that place

Elective Courses – General Information

- Grade 11 students require 5 electives
- Choose electives that make sense for future planning (i.e look to the grade 12 course prerequisites)
- Consider courses that satisfy Group 2 or Group 3 Graduation requirements
- Sciences are electives (they are NOT MANDATORY)
- PAI 3O1 Small Groups Phys Ed course fee (approx. \$200) associated with course

- COOP 2 credit or 4 credit
 - Earn credits while gaining workplace experience
 - Begin OYAP in semester 2 as part of your COOP program
 - Satisfies Group 2 & 3 graduation requirement
- All students MUST select an ALTERNATIVE COURSE**


Choosing, reviewing, and submitting your courses on myBlueprint

Course Selection for the 2024/2025 school year will open on Thursday February 22, 2024 and will close on Thursday February 29, 2024.






STEP 1: Login to your myBlueprint account via The Log In button






STEP 2: From the Dashboard, click on Plan Courses




STEP 3: Add Online Learning Opt-Out.






STEP 4: Add courses to your High School Plan. Click on + Course to select courses.

Please ensure that you add an alternative course.






STEP 5: Click on Review Course Selections to review the courses you have chosen.








